- 1 in 4 adolescents report being physically, emotionally, or sexually abused by a dating partner each year
- 40% of high school females report being hurt by a dating partner
- Teen Dating Violence victimization was the most significant risk factor for perpetration of dating violence for girls and boys of all grade levels
- Future Teen Dating Violence prevention efforts should target adolescents earlier and be tailored to gender and grade level
